# Round Up Information

### Appliance/Electronics Round Up:

An appliance round up is sponsored at the Recycling Center in the spring. Items accepted at this round up include stoves, refrigerators, microwaves, televisions, computers, etc. for a minimal fee.

### **Tire Round Up:**

A tire round up is sponsored in the spring as well as fall. All tires that are NOT on rims are accepted. A minimal fee is based on the size of the tire.

### **Chemical Clean Sweep:**


A Chemical Clean Sweep is sponsored periodically, usually in early summer. Any type of chemical including herbicides, pesticides, mercury, lead based paints, thinners, etc. can be turned in for disposal with this ecofriendly collection. This is a NO FEE collection program.

### **Items That Are Recyclable**

All items may be co-mingled and placed in brown grocery bags or plastic bags. Here is a list of items that are accepted for recycling. Accepted items MUST be rinsed clean, caps removed and collapsed to reduce volume

- Glass—Food and Beverage Bottles and Jars.
- Plastics—#1 through #7.
- ♦ Tin
- Metals—Rims, brake shoes, auto parts, scrap metals, etc. are accepted, if not contaminated.
  A Metals Dumpster is available for larger items at the Jackson County Recycling Center.
- Aerosol & Paint Cans—Need to be empty and dry. Lids removed.
- Newspaper & Phone Books—Please leave loose.
- Magazines & Glossy Paper—All magazines, stapled or glued, and cartons are accepted. Please leave loose.
- Office & Computer Paper—White or colored paper including copy paper, stationary, white envelopes, pastel paper and window envelopes.
- Cardboard & Manila Envelopes—Corrugated or ribbed cardboard ONLY. Boxes MUST be flattened. For large quantities of cardboard,

please deliver to the Recycling Center. The cardboard size should be smaller than  $2 \times 4$ .

### **Items NOT ACCEPTED**

- NO GARBAGE!
- ♦ NO STYROFOAM PRODUCTS!
- NO WINDOW GLASS, DRINKING GLASS-ES, LIGHT BULBS, PICTURE TUBES, DISHES, CERAMICS, STONEWARE, POTTERY, PERFUME OR AFTER SHAVE BOTTLES!
- NO CAPS OR LIDS ON BOTTLES OR JARS!
- NO OILY OR GREASY CARDBOARD OR GRAYBOARD!
- NO PERSONAL HYGIENE ITEMS!

Yard waste such as branches or grass clippings and solid waste (garbage) is NOT handled by the County or Drop Sites.
