ORDINANCE No. 1-08

The Town Board of the Town of North Bend, Jackson County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to s.60.30 (1e) (a), Wis. Stat., the office of the town clerk and town treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members elect of the town board.

The term of office for the appointed positions shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years, s.60.30 (1e) (c), Wis. Stat. The appointed officers may be re-appointed for additional terms, subject to town board approval. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for *cause* as defined under s.17.001, Wis. Stat. and s.60.30 (1e)(f), Wis. Stat.

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on April 1, 2008. The referendum question shall be:

"Shall the person holding the office of town clerk and the person holding the office of town treasurer in the Town of North Bend be appointed by the Town Board?"

The salary of the appointed positions shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and publication as required by law.
